One of the largest Bahamian islands, Eleuthera is about 100 miles long and 2 miles wide. The House

Bahama Villa has two separate-level decks with excellent views of Ten Bay Beach. Bask in the scenery, or walk down the path to your very own bay for a swim. The house has new central AC and is comfortably furnished for 4 people, with 2 BRs, 1 bath, fully-equipped kitchen and great room.

The master bedroom has a king-sized bed, and large sliding glass door that opens to the deck's tropical breezes. The other bedroom has twin beds. There are ceiling fans and bright colors throughout the house. The great room has a futon sofa, wicker chairs, Satellite TV/VCR/DVD and games, movies and other diversions. Snorkeling gear and inflatable rafts are kept in the lower deck.




Transportation

Cars are available to rent on the island, with prices ranging from \$55/day and up. You can rent one from your Bahamian host Arthur Nixon at a special guest discount of \$50/day, or rent an off-road vehicle with help from Arthur.

Either way, he can meet you at the airport with your transport and give you directions to the grocery store, sights, etc.

Food & Entertainment

Groceries are available within a few minutes' drive into Palmetto Point or Governor's Harbour. Entertainment and restaurants – some with live bands - are also nearby. All this in addition to caves, miles of empty beaches, local festivals, and sultry Caribbean nights!!



Prices

Prices quoted here are for 2 guests. Fee for extra guests (up to 6 max. occupancy) is \$15 per person per night.

Year-Round Rate: \$995 per week; \$170 per night (3 nights minimum).

Christmas/New Yrs: \$1500/week; or \$2700 for both weeks.

Reservations are made on a first-come, first-served basis, so make your plans early! The house is rented on a weekly basis, although sometimes allowances are made for short stays or partial rentals (3 nights min. when available) for \$170/night, plus \$55 cleaning.
